<i>Indigenous communities have inherited and continue to endure a non-holistic learning that creates difficulties for Aboriginal students. This workshop argues the urgent need for Indigenous peoples to re-create classrooms and learning through the development of culturally informed and holistic learning approaches that are focused on transformational and healing learning outcomes.</i> <i>This workshop will discuss the history of emotional suppression as a form of colonialism and document its impact on the education and learning of indigenous peoples in North America. Then present a transformational view of learning within a cultural contest that builds on the concept of affective development based in Aboriginal philosophy. Six principles of emotional competency are discussed in relation to the development of an emotionally inclusive curriculum</i>

<i>Due to the effects of colonization and residential school there has been a breakdown of parenting skills within our family systems. In our family systems, the virtues of respect, humility, love, kindness responsibility was role modeled and taught by our Elders, parents, and caregivers generations ago. By going back to our traditional values we are relearning how our ancestors lived. A system that was very powerful in that it promoted unity. Throughout a 2-3 day workshop participants will learn using the 5 strategies of the Virtues Project™ and how we can go back to using these very important virtues. We can never totally go back to living how our ancestors lived, however these are some tools that we can still use today in raising our children. This program can be very helpful in all areas of wellness, the workplace</i>			

and for organizations.
